




## Introduction

Tipperary County Council, in partnership with Limerick City and County Council, Transport Infrastructure Ireland and the Department of Transport are progressing the N24 Cahir to Limerick Junction Project. The overall aim of the N24 project is to deliver a reliable and sustainable transport solution that will encourage balanced regional development and improve the quality of life of residents along this corridor.

## Project Progress Update

The Option Selection Report is going through a final review and is due to be published in this month. This report will be made available on the project website ([www.n24cahirlimerick.ie](http://www.n24cahirlimerick.ie)).



The Option Selection Report contains all of the supporting detail behind each step in the analysis during Phase 2, documenting both the assessments undertaken and the decisions made. The finalisation of the Option Selection Report however has not delayed the progression of the project which is currently at Phase 3, Design and Evaluation.

Since the conclusion of Public Display No. 3 for the Preferred Transport Solution in May 2022, the project team have been progressing the design of the active travel, demand management and road components of the Preferred Transport Solution. The Preferred Option Corridor for the road component published in May 2022 as part of the Preferred Transport Solution has been refined to a 100m wide corridor. This refined 100m wide corridor lies predominantly within the 300m wide corridor that was published for the Preferred Transport Solution in May 2022. However, following detailed consideration of landowner engagement, stakeholder feedback, environmental surveys, and design development, the corridor diverges at a number of locations. In addition, proposed junction locations have been identified and are currently being developed. Potential active travel routes and demand management measures have also been identified. This design update (Design Update No. 1) was published on the project website on 23 January 2023. A copy of the design update No. 1 drawings are available to view or download on the project website.

Property owners along the refined 100m wide corridor for the road component of the Preferred Transport Solution were notified on 23 January 2023 by post and are invited to consult with the project team, either in person, or by online or telephone meetings.

As part of the Design and Environmental Evaluation Phase of the project, environmental and topographical surveys are currently being undertaken within an area which includes, but is not limited to, the corridor for the road component for the Preferred Transport Solution, and will continue over the coming months. Letters have been issued to inform landowners of these surveys.

## What Happens Next

Archaeological geophysics will take place in Q1 and Q2 2023 and directly affected landowners will be contacted by letter in advance of any works taking place. Similarly, detailed ground investigations are expected to take place in Q2 2023, and directly affected landowners will be contacted by letter in advance of any works taking place.

As the design progresses, the project team will continue to engage with landowners and relevant stakeholders to discuss the design and any potential impacts and identify potential mitigation measures.
