



Introduction

Tipperary County Council, in partnership with Limerick City and County Council, Transport Infrastructure Ireland and the Department of Transport are progressing the N24 Cahir to Limerick Junction Project. The overall aim of the N24 project is to deliver a reliable and sustainable transport solution that will encourage balanced regional development and improve the quality of life of residents along this corridor.

Project Progress Update

The project is currently at Phase 3 (Design and Environmental Evaluation).

Design Update No. 1 was published on 23 January 2023. This included potential active travel routes, proposed demand management measures and a refined 100m wide corridor for the road component of the Preferred Transport Solution. The project team continue to be available to meet with members of the public to discuss this design update and the team are progressing the design taking on board any feedback received.

Environmental and topographical surveys continue within an area which includes, but is not limited to, the corridor for the road component for the Preferred Transport Solution and will continue over the coming months. Letters have been issued to inform landowners of these surveys.

Equally, non-intrusive archaeological geophysics surveys started in March 2023 and directly affected landowners were informed by letter of these surveys. The purpose of these surveys is to identify the extent of any potential subsurface archaeological remains or any geophysical anomalies in the areas surrounding any known existing archaeology.

Ground investigations commenced in April 2023, and directly affected landowners were informed by letter of these investigations.



What Happens Next

As the design progresses, the project team will engage with landowners and relevant stakeholders to discuss the design and any potential impacts and identify potential mitigation measures.
