



Introduction

Tipperary County Council, in partnership with Limerick City and County Council, Transport Infrastructure Ireland and the Department of Transport are progressing the N24 Cahir to Limerick Junction Project. The overall aim of the N24 project is to deliver a reliable and sustainable transport solution that will encourage balanced regional development and improve the quality of life of residents along this corridor.

Project Progress Update

The project is currently at Phase 3 (Design and Environmental Evaluation).

The design of the Preferred Transport Solution is being progressed by the design team who are taking on board feedback received following stakeholder engagement including one-to-one landowner meetings.

Environmental surveys continue within an area which includes, but is not limited to, the corridor for the road component for the Preferred Transport Solution and will continue over the coming months. Letters were issued this month to those with lands relating to Barn owl which are due to commence in the coming month.

On site ground investigations are currently on hold due to poor weather conditions. The PLO is in permanent contact with affected landowners to coordinate the completion of these works.

As part of our studies on the design and environmental evaluation, a noise monitoring programme is on-going to assess the existing environment in the vicinity of the corridor for the road component of the Preferred Transport Solution. An integral part of this monitoring programme involves the measurement of noise levels at selected locations over a 24-hour period.

Traffic surveys to inform the design of active travel measures are due to take place in early March 2024.



What Happens Next

The design team will further progress the road and active travel components of the Preferred Transport Solution to incorporate feedback from stakeholder engagement and any mitigation measures identified from the environmental studies. The project team continue to be available to discuss the design and are available for in-person meetings or site visits.
